AIDS Coordination

The AIDS Coordination and Information Services (ACIS) unit, Field Operations Division, provides a central contact point for persons with Human Immunodeficiency Virus disease and their families to obtain information on a variety of health care and social service needs. The unit coordinates HIV/AIDS related activities within the Oklahoma Department of Human Services and HIV/AIDS activities with other public and private entities throughout the state.

Care coordinators, located in Oklahoma City and Tulsa, provide information and referral, client assessment, advocacy and intervention, access to contract services and follow-up services to assure the client is receiving what is needed. These staff are also involved in the development and coordination of community resources to fill gaps and eliminate duplication of services.





There are no income or resource restrictions for case management services; HIV infection is the only eligibility criteria and referrals are accepted from any location in the state.

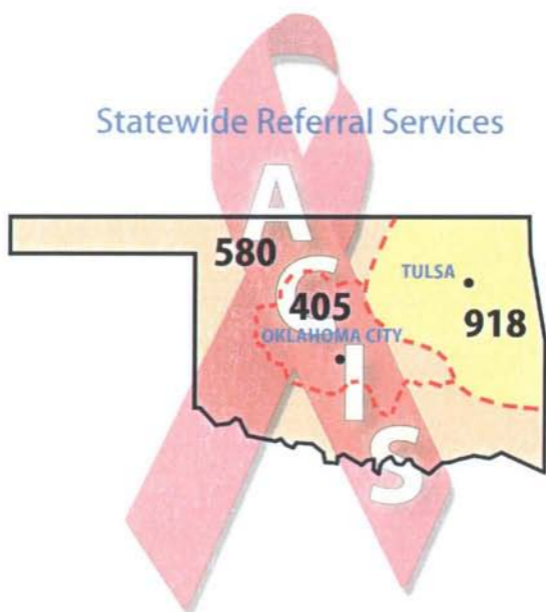
