

OKLAHOMA SALES TAX RELIEF ACT

If you are a **TANF** recipient, your monthly TANF benefit includes Sales Tax Relief money. Therefore, you are **NOT** eligible for a Sales Tax Refund if you received TANF for **any** month in 2009.

If you received a **State Supplemental Payment (SSP) to the Aged, Blind, or Disabled**, or your care in a **Nursing Facility was paid by SoonerCare (Medicaid) every month without a break** from January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009, then OKDHS will send you a Sales Tax Refund by the end of January 2010.

- If you received **SSP**, your Sales Tax Refund will be sent to you in the same manner, **by debit card or direct deposit**.
- If you live in a **Nursing Facility**, you will be issued a **check**.

If you do not receive this refund, contact your local OKDHS office for assistance. Under certain circumstances, you may still have to apply for the Sales Tax Refund on your own after talking to the local OKDHS office.

If you receive the Sales Tax Refund from OKDHS, then you **must not** file a Sales Tax Relief application (form 538-S) with the Oklahoma Tax Commission.
