



Eligibility Schedule/Rates for Adult Day Services

I. Adult Day Services co-payment schedule

OKDHS staff uses the schedule of copayments chart on page 1 of this appendix to determine the family share copayment based on income and number of persons in the household. The client pays his or her co-payment directly to the provider at the beginning of each month. The provider must return a portion of the client share co-payment to the client or guardian if the care used by the client (the daily rate per participant times the number of days the participant attended) amounts to less than the co-payment. OKDHS makes payments to the Adult Day Service provider on the claims submitted after the co-payments have been deducted.

Income eligible clients use the following scale, based on income and household size to determine the amount of adult day services co-payments.

II. OKDHS rate of pay

The rate for adult day services aged 60 years and older, and individuals under the age of 60 with age waivers cannot exceed \$60 per person per day. An hourly rate of \$7.50 is paid for attendance for up to eight hours in any one day. If needed, care may be based on a seven day week.
